The Access Office promotes access to MTU for groups who are under-represented in higher education. This includes students with disabilities, including students with learning difference, mental health and significant ongoing health conditions; students who are experiencing social and economic barriers to education, mature students, Traveller & Roma students and ethnic minority students. The Access Office also provides support and information to students on financial supports, bursaries and scholarships. Staff from the Access Office will be available to discuss available supports including assistive technology.
